Following agents in our HMR are under special surveillance, and unexpected positive findings in our health monitoring program are addressed by the Laboratory Animal Veterinarian and Head of Scientific Management. Relevant measures are taken depending on the agent in question. This can include further diagnostic analysis, re-testing of the epidemiological unit, changes to hygienic and preventive measures, etc.
